JUST IMAGE VISION FOR OUR HOMESTEAD

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) has designated 2.4 acres within our homestead for a non-residential facility that will include a gymnasium and dormitories. This facility is intended to serve the Kaumana community by offering spaces for:

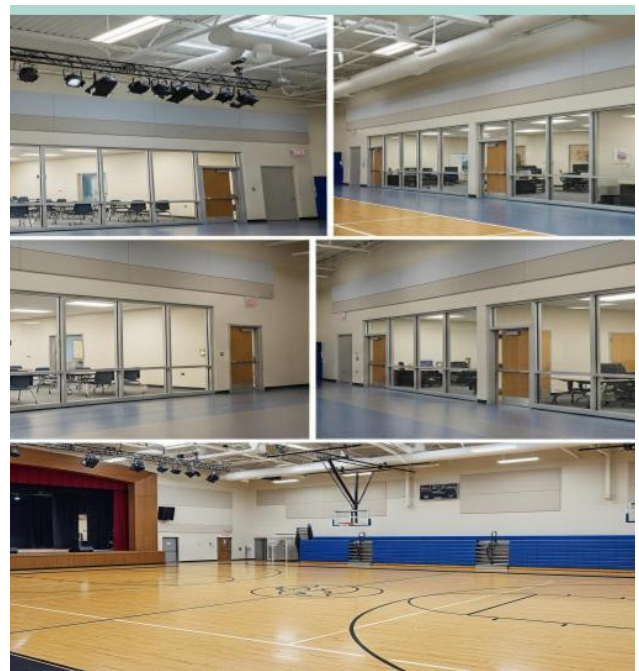
- Exercise

- A Pre-Kindergarten school

Additionally, we plan to incorporate a commercial kitchen and housing facilities to address the critical need for accommodations for sports tourism and the Merrie Monarch Festival.

2.4 acres have been designated as a non-residential area for our homestead, where we aspire to establish a Hawaiian Cultural Center. This center will enable us to honor Prince Kuhio's desire to revitalize our Hawaiian heritage, offering vital support and education for future generations.
